

Participating and Supporting Faculty – Draft 06/14/07

Participating Faculty Defined

A participating faculty member is one with whom the College anticipates a long-term or continuing relationship, whether or not contractually stated. A participating faculty member is actively involved in departmental and college activities beyond his or her teaching responsibilities. Participating faculty members may be either academically qualified or professionally qualified. Participating faculty members are expected to attend faculty meetings and engage in department, college, university, and professional service activities.

Supporting Faculty Defined

A supporting faculty member is one who is engaged on a semester by semester basis. A supporting faculty member is not actively involved in departmental and college activities beyond his or her teaching responsibilities and expectations to be reasonably available to students for help with their classes. Supporting faculty members may be either academically qualified or professionally qualified. Supporting faculty members are not expected to attend faculty meetings or to engage in department, college, or university service.
